Chi-Ha from 1st Tank regiment, 2nd Company. Malaysian Campaign 1941-42.



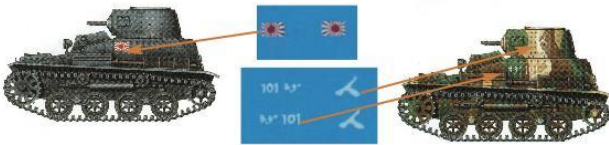
## Type 2597 Chi-Ha

9th Tank Regiment, Saipan July 1944. Red six in red rectangle on white base signifies 6th Company of 9th Regiment.



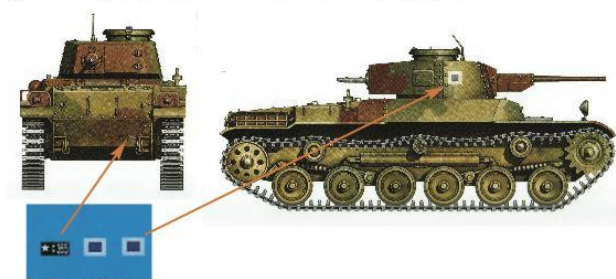
## Type 94 tankette

Left: navy tankette in blue-gray. Right: Quantung camo.



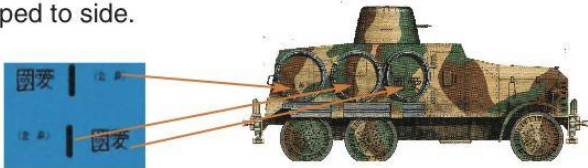
## Type 1 Chi-he

Ho-ni of 2nd Company, 2nd Tank Division, Saipan 1944.



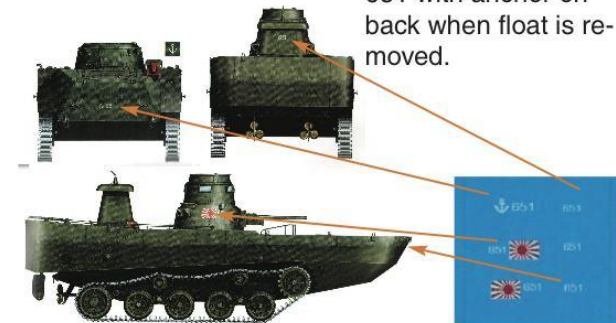
## Type 89

Vehicle 8918, modified type with straight glacis.



## Type 2 Ka-mi

Amphibious tank of the 101st Special Naval Landing Force, Leyte, Philippines, October 1944. Note no. 651 on back of smoke stack and bough sides, and 651 with anchor on back when float is removed.



## Type 89

Two vehicles, one, 8954, and '7'. No. 8954 is probably of 2nd Company, 7th Tank Regiment, Gonkiang, China 1939. It has a ditching tail, like no 8918. No '7' modified early type with old glacis and suspension, and 'top hat' copula like 8918.
