



Yugoslav Army, post WW2 72019

In general, vehicles taken over from Nazi-Germany, were given a white three-digit number, displayed on the turret sides or superstructure, in addition to a white roundel displaying a black tank-symbol. Vehicles obtained from US, British or Russian stocks tended to just have a smaller four or five-digit white number on the turret side or superstructure. Vehicles from the former allies were generally painted in a light and blueish olive drab (see picture of M-36 Jackson). The colours from former Nazi-vehicles are most probably the same. Post-war produced vehicles were of the same colour or in a camouflage pattern of mid-green, combined with light grass green and sometimes chocolate brown and mud yellow.

Sturmgeschütz III

Vehicle number and tank emblem are both on the vehicle superstructure. This vehicle seems to still carry Zimmerit coating.
