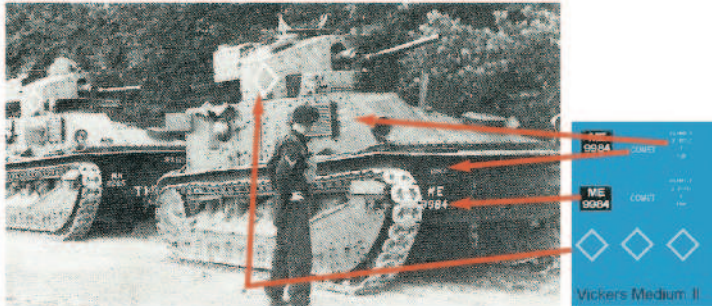




The Interbellum - British Army 72030

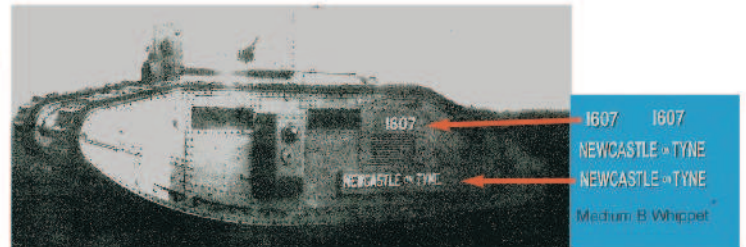

Vickers Medium Tank Mk II



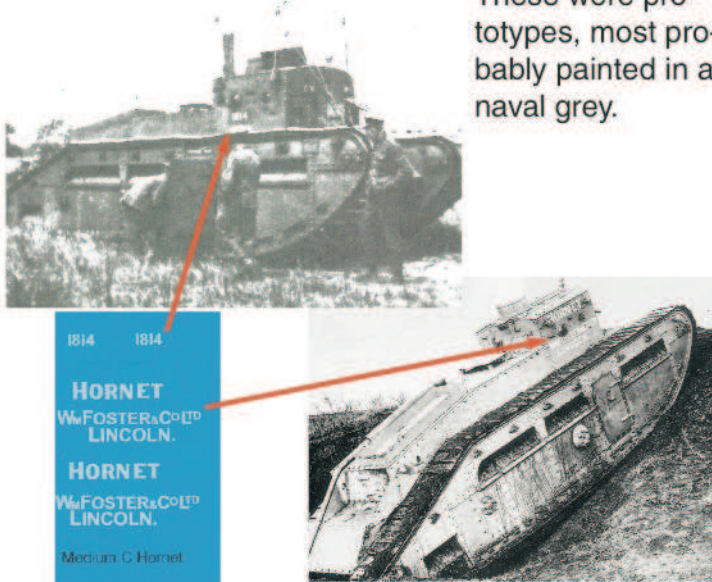
Medium Tank B 'Whippet'

This vehicle was painted in a sandy dark earth.



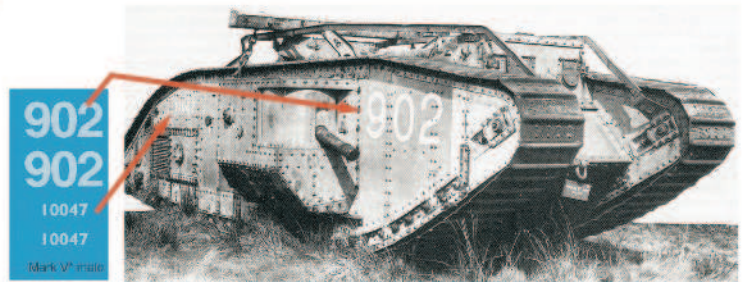
Medium Tank C Hornet

These were prototypes, most probably painted in a naval grey.



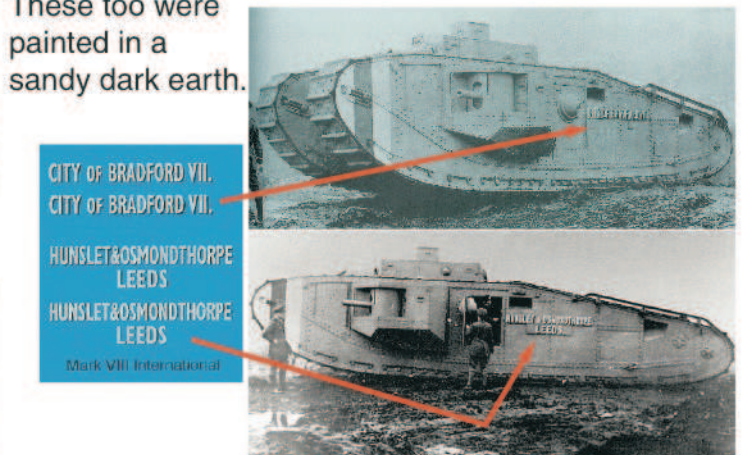
Mark Vstar Male

Though these V-stars fought in WW1, this particular vehicles was only used for training purposes.

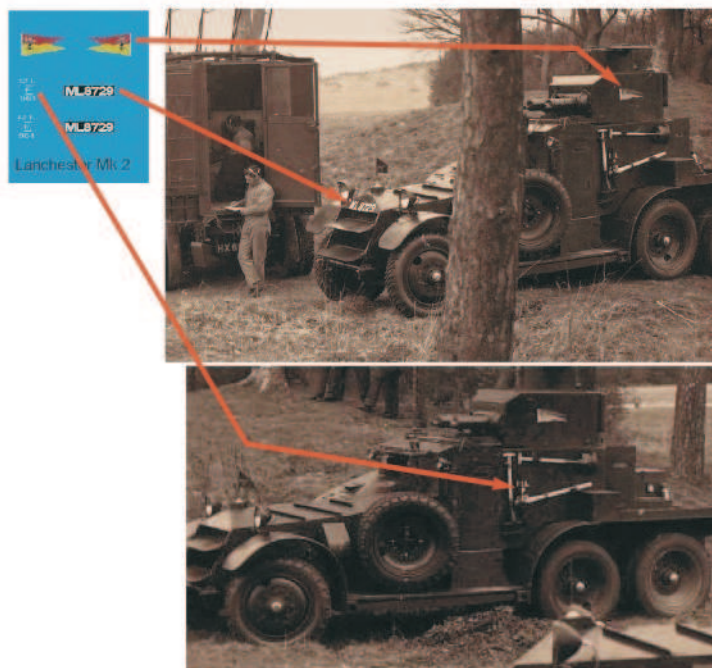


Mark VIII International
